

PROVINCIAL ROAD MANAGEMENT FACILITY (PRMF)



The Provincial Roads Management Facility (PRMF) is an Australian Funded Project implemented by the Government of the Philippines through the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG). The program is a five (5) year program which started in 2010.

The PRMF is a governance reform program that will use road maintenance as an incentive to change. The objectives of the PRMF are the following:

1. Improve the sustainable provision, management and maintenance of a core network of provincial roads in targetted provinces;
2. Strengthen the provincial institutional capacity and governance systems related to the provision and maintenance of provincial roads;

The major areas in governance that will be strengthened under the program are access to resources (funding, personnel and office equipment); budget; expenditure management; planning, internal control; human resource management, service delivery mechanisms; and the road planning management and maintenance.

The components of the PRMF:

1. Capacity building for provincial road sector planning and management;
2. Incentive Fund to encourage provinces to pursue reforms in road sector planning and management of provincial roads; and
3. Road Network Rehabilitation and maintenance of 1,500 kilometers of provincial roads.
